## **Points of Clarification:**

## \*\*ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CHANGES MARKED BY ASTERISKS SHALL BE IN EFFECT AS OF AUGUST 2018.\*\*

- \*\*A third year of a language is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED, but not required as a part of the Monticello Academy. Any Junior student, however, must either take an AP Elective Course or a third year of a language.\*\*
- \*\*If a Junior is taking AP Seminar and also chooses to take another AP Elective or a third year of a language, then the AP Elective or language class shall take the place of one of the two Elective spots designated for the student's schedule.\*\*
- \*\*A Senior Monticello student shall NOT be required to take an AP Science UNLESS they took AP Computer Science Principles during their Sophomore year instead of AP Chemistry. It is, however, highly recommended for a Senior that does not need another year of AP Science to do so in order to boost their viability on their transcript for college admittance.\*\*
- All Freshmen and Sophomore students shall be required to take a foreign language during their first two years in the program.
- Any Monticello student may choose to drop one AP course between their freshman and sophomore year provided that they have been enrolled in the class for at least one nine week period. The student must speak with their guidance counselor about dropping the course, at which point the counselor should forward the request to a Monticello Coordinator for review. Until they have completed at least one nine week period, contacted their guidance counselor and received approval from a Monticello Coordinator, they shall not be allowed to use said drop.
- Any Monticello student may choose to drop one AP course between their junior and senior year provided that they have been enrolled in the class for at least one nine week period. The student must speak with their guidance counselor about dropping the course, at which point the counselor should forward the request to a Monticello Coordinator for review. Until they have completed at least one nine week period, contacted their guidance counselor and received approval from a Monticello Coordinator, they shall not be allowed to use said drop.
